RECIPROCAL BORROWING POLICY

To obtain a free JCPL borrower's card, a reciprocal borrower must show a valid resident library card from a library which participates in the Reciprocal Borrowing Program.

<u>Borrowing privileges</u> allow reciprocal borrowers to borrow all materials which are available to residents of the JCPL service area except for electronic resources that are pay-per-use such as Hoopla. We will *intra*library loan (within the JCPL system) for reciprocal borrowers.

<u>PC's</u>: PC's providing public access to the Internet, research resources, spreadsheet and word processing software and to the library catalog will be available to reciprocal borrowers.

<u>Interlibrary loan (from other libraries):</u> Reciprocal borrowers may request items via Indiana's Statewide Remote Circulation System (SRCS). For *inter*library loans via InShare, reciprocal borrowers must go to their own library.
